<p>I can multiply and divide whole numbers and those involving decimals by 10, 100 & 1000 and explain the effect.</p> <p>Example question: What is 4.5×100? How do you know?</p>	<p>Click here to watch Maths Mansion about multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000.</p>	<p>Multiply by 10, 100 and 1000.</p>
<p>I can halve any number with up to one decimal place.</p> <p>Example question: What is half of 14.9?</p>	<p>Partition or 'split' the number. It also helps to think of the number as money. For the example question, half of £14 = £7 Half of £0.90 (or 90p) = £0.45 (or 45p) So, half of 14.9 = 7.45</p>	<p>Hit the button! Select 'halves' from the menu, and then 'halves to 10 (1dp)'</p> <p>Super Maths Bowling. Select '17.Double Decimals' from the menu.</p> <p>Interactive Questions</p>
<p>I know by heart all squares of multiples of 10 up to 100.</p> <p>Example question: What is 40 squared (40^2 or 40×40)?</p>	<p>For the example question, calculate 4^2 first ($4 \times 4 = 16$). Then, multiply your answer by 10 (160) and 10 again (1600) because the question was 40×40</p>	<p>Hit the button! Select 'Square Numbers' from the menu</p> <p>Fishing Select 'Square Numbers' from the menu</p>
<p>I recognise and use cube numbers.</p> <p>Example question: What is 4 cubed (4^3 or $4 \times 4 \times 4$)?</p>	<p>Click here to find out more about cube numbers!</p>	<p>Monty's wall Select 'Multiplication' from the main menu, and then 'Y5 Cube Numbers'</p> <p>Fishing Select 'Cube Numbers' from the menu</p> <p>Cube Questions</p>
<p>I can count forwards and backwards in steps of powers of 10 for any number up to 1,000,000.</p> <p>Example questions: What is 10 less than 45 506? What is 1000 more than 69 564?</p>	<p>Powers of 10 simply means 10, 100, 1000, 10,000, 100,000 etc.</p>
